

Subject: Water Fun Games & End of Year Party

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Good afternoon. Trust this email finds you well!

The end of term is approaching fast and as usual, we are planning to hold the very much awaited 'Water Fun Day' for our youngsters of the Pre-Junior classes next week. Please note that the date for this event was originally scheduled to take place on Monday coming, the 25th June, however we have decided to postpone the date to **Wednesday 27th June** in view of the fact that the pools have not yet been set up. We are hoping to have the pools ready by Wednesday and that our little boys and girls will be able to enjoy some slashing and swimming on the day. Thus, half the morning will be dedicated to water play, swimming and water games in our areas outside.

The students are expected to come to school wearing their bathing suits (we recommend the one piece protective suit) underneath their summer uniform and should bring along with them a cap/hat, towel, inflated arm bands, beach shoes, underwear and socks. All items/clothing including the arm bands should be labelled. The teachers and helpers will then help the children change back into their summer uniform afterwards.

We will also be setting up a 'Mini Ice-cream Stall' on this day. The children will have the opportunity to prepare a 'DIY Ice-Cream' by choosing from a selection of flavours and then decorate it by choosing from a variety of toppings. (Ice Cream fee included in the 8 Euro which will be collected for the party expenses held on Thursday 28th June).

We will celebrate our last day of school with an 'End of Term Party' which will be held on **Thursday 28th June**. The students are to come to school wearing casual clothes. The party fee is 8 Euro. This includes a kinder brioss for breakfast time, party food, water, orange juice and animation.(& the ice-cream which will be given to the students on Wednesday 27th June). Parents are kindly requested to send the payment in a sealed envelope with the child's name and class written clearly on and hand it over to the class teacher responsible by latest Tuesday 26th June.

May we now take the opportunity to thank all the parents for their positive feedback, constant support and co-operation throughout the year. It has been a pleasure for us to educate your children and see them grow into little, more independent, caring and well-mannered boys and girls. We thank you once again for entrusting your children in our care.
